

WHAT'S YOUR COLOR?

The most exciting and unique feature of a 3000BC HOME Event is the 3000BC Skin Scope, which identifies skin conditions that illuminate and gives you a look beneath your skin. The Skin Scope is designed to detect dehydration, sun damage, cellular build up, and excess oil. You will actually be able to see these disorders on your own skin as we point out different color patterns. You place your head in the Skin Scope and look at your face with a set of surrounding mirrors. Sun damage appears brown. Dehydration will show itself as purple. Oily areas appear yellow.

WHAT IS BROWN?

Brown reveals signs of accelerated aging from the effects of sun exposure, environmental stress and inherent genetic factors. UV spots are generally invisible under normal lighting conditions. The Skin Scope detects damaged skin conditions. So if you have brown areas, these are spots on the skin such as hyper-pigmentation, freckles, and age spots. The entire collection of products for the brown category will stimulate the growth of healthy new skin, provide intensive hydration, reduce wrinkles and protect skin from future free radical induced damage.

WHAT IS PURPLE?

When the skin illuminates purple in our skin scope, this is an indication of surface dehydration, which is a crippling enemy of the skin affecting up to 98% of the populations in varying degrees, and is associated with problems as diverse as scaly, taut skin, superficial lines and premature aging. Given the singular importance of dehydration, it is necessary to understand the function of the skin in order to treat it properly. This collection of products for the purple category will deliver intensive hydration, reduce wrinkles and fine lines, and increase cell turnover for a deeply moisturized, smooth complexion.

WHAT IS YELLOW?

Yellow is oily. Light yellow is acne: a blackhead, whiteheads, zits, bumps, goobers, pustules or papules or just yuck go away. The overproduction of bacteria, getting lodged in our skin cells (which look like the shingles of a house) lead to the plugging of our pores, a dull lackluster appearance, and the unsightly blemishes that we hate! Your skin can be both oily and dehydrated. This is common! Often times oily skin types unknowingly dehydrate their skin of its vital water. We will teach you how to shed those shingles while maintaining moisture. This is the key to eliminating the yellow/orange hue found in the scope.
